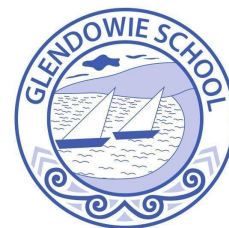


Policy Glendowie School

3. FEES REFUND CONDITIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



Rationale : There is no refund of tuition fees except in the circumstances outlined below. The Board recognises its policy and guidelines have been designed so that the outcome for a request for a fee refund should be fair and reasonable for all. The following principles allow the school to consider the merits of each request.

Guidelines

In order to be eligible for any refund set out in the points below, the parent or legal Guardian must apply in writing to the Board of Trustees setting out the special circumstances of the claim for a refund.

Request for a refund of international student fees

1. The School will consider all requests for a refund of international student fees. Requests should be made in writing to the School as soon as possible after the circumstances leading to a request.
2. A request for a refund should provide the following information to the School:
 - a) The name of the student
 - b) The circumstances of the request
 - c) The amount of refund requested
 - d) The name of the person requesting the refund
 - e) The name of the person who paid the fees
 - f) The bank account details to receive any eligible refund
 - g) Any relevant supporting documentation such as receipts or invoice

Non-refundable fees

3. The School is unable to refund some fees. The following fees relate to expenses that the school may have paid or will incur as a result of receiving an application for enrolment and cannot be refunded:
 - a) **Administration Fee:** Administration fees meet the cost of processing an international student application. Administration fees exist whether an application is accepted or not or whether a student remains enrolled after an application is accepted.
 - b) **Insurance:** Once insurance is purchased, the school is unable to refund insurance premiums paid on behalf of the student. Students and families may apply directly to an insurance company for a refund of premiums paid.
 - c) **Homestay Placement Fee:** Homestay placement fees meet the cost of processing a request for homestay accommodation by the student. Costs incurred for arranging homestay accommodation for the student prior to the refund request, cannot be refunded.
 - d) **Used Homestay Fees:** Homestay fees paid for time the student has already spent in a homestay cannot be refunded. Used homestay fees may also include a notice period of a week.

- e) **Portion of Unused Tuition Fees:** The School may retain a portion of unused tuition fees. Amounts retained will relate to costs that have been incurred or committed by the school and may vary.

Request for a refund for failure to obtain a study visa or for reasons relating to Covid-19

4.

- a) If the student fails to obtain an appropriate study visa, a refund of international student tuition fees will be provided less any Administration Fee that has been paid.
- b) If the student withdraws before the start of their enrolment, owing to medical or travel conditions arising from Covid-19, the school will provide a full refund of fees.

Requests for a refund for voluntary withdrawal from enrolment - Withdrawal before enrolment

5.

- a) If the student voluntarily withdraws more than three weeks before the start date of their enrolment, a refund of international student fees will be provided less any relevant non-refundable fees set out in this policy.
- b) If the student voluntarily withdraws three weeks or less before the start date of their enrolment, a refund of international student fees will be provided less a minimum of ten weeks tuition fees and any relevant non-refundable fees set out in this policy.

Requests for a refund for voluntary withdrawal from enrolment - Withdrawal after enrolment

6.

- a) If the student withdraws on or after the start date of their enrolment, reasonable written notice of withdrawal is required by the school. Unless otherwise agreed by the school, a refund will be provided less a minimum of ten weeks tuition fees and any other relevant non-refundable fees as outlined in this policy. The minimum ten week notice period will begin the day after the date on which the school receives written notice of the student's intention to withdraw.
- b) A refund may be made where the student returns home due to serious illness of the student or because of a death or serious illness of a close family member. This must be supported by medical evidence. In that event the refund will be calculated less the administration fee.
- c) A refund may be made where the student travel is restricted due to border closes e.g. in the case of a pandemic

Requests for a refund for enrolment of one term or less

- 7. Where the student is enrolled for one term or less and withdraws early, or where the school terminates the student's enrolment, any unused portion of international student fees will not be refunded.

Requests for a refund where the School fails to provide a course, ceases as a signatory or ceases to be a provider

- 8. If the school fails to provide the agreed course of education or is no longer a signatory to the Code or no longer operates as an international education provider, the school will negotiate with the student or their family to either:
 - a) Refund the unused portion of international student tuition fees or other fees paid for services not delivered or

- b) Transfer the amount of any eligible refund to another provider or
- c) Make other arrangements agreed to by the student or their family and the school.

Where the Student's enrolment is ended by the School

9. In the event the student's enrolment is ended by the School for a breach of the Contract of Enrolment, the school will consider a request for a refund less:
- a) Any non-refundable fees set out in this policy
 - b) Ten weeks tuition fees from the dates of termination
 - c) Any other reasonable costs that the school has incurred in ending the student's enrolment

Where the Student changes to a domestic student during the period of enrolment

10. If the student changes to a domestic student after the start date of their enrolment, reasonable written notice of the change is required by the School. Unless otherwise agreed by the School, a refund will be provided less a minimum of ten weeks tuition fee and any other relevant non-refundable fees as outlined in this policy. The ten weeks will begin the day after the school receives written evidence of the student's domestic student status.

Where the Student voluntarily requests to transfer to another signatory

11. If the student requests to transfer to another signatory after the start date of their enrolment, reasonable written notice of the transfer is required by the School. Unless otherwise agreed by the school, a refund will be provided less a minimum of ten weeks tuition fees and any other relevant non-refundable fees as outlined in this policy. The ten weeks will begin the day after the school receives written notice of the student's intended withdrawal.

Request for a refund of homestay fees

12. If for any reason the student withdraws after the start of their stay in a school homestay, any unused homestay fees will be refunded, less any relevant non-refundable fees set out in this policy.
13. Where a student moves from a school homestay and requests a refund of any unused homestay fees, these will be refunded less any non-refundable fees set out in this policy. If the student requests the school to find another homestay then this will incur a new homestay placement fee.

Requests for a refund of fees unused at the end of enrolment

14. Except by written request from parents, prepaid fees unused at the end of enrolment amounting to less than NZD\$300 will be refunded to the student in cash. Sums of NZD\$300 or greater will be refunded into a nominated bank account.

Outstanding activity fees or other fees

15. Any activity or other fees incurred by the Student during enrolment and owed to the school at the time of withdrawal, will be deducted from any eligible refund.

Refunds to be made to the country of receipt

16. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, all eligible refunds of fees of NZD\$1,000.00 or more received from outside of New Zealand will be refunded to a nominated bank account in the source country.

Rights of families after a decision regarding a refund has been made by the School

17. A decision by the school relating to a request for a refund of international student fees will be provided to the student or parents in writing and will set out the following information:
- a) Factors considered when making the refund decision
 - b) The total amount to be refunded
 - c) Details of non-refundable fees
18. Where a student withdraws after commission has already been paid by the school to the agent, the cost of the commission will be deducted from any refund.
19. In the event the student or their parent is dissatisfied with a refund decision made by the school or are dissatisfied with the process the School followed when making the refund decision, they have the right to have the refund decision reviewed by the International Student Disputes Resolution Scheme or to make a complaint to the Code Administrator.
