



Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Agreement for Years 5 to 8

Updated: Feb 2023

I want my child to bring their own device to school for use in the classroom learning programme.

I understand (*please tick each statement*):

- All devices brought to school are my child's responsibility and the insurance for the device is my responsibility.
- The school holds no responsibility for any loss or damage which might occur. This includes both software (virus, malware etc) as well as hardware.
- That teachers will provide a cabinet in which my child may store their device when not in use.
- Children should bring devices to school each day, fully charged.
- My child will ensure they are signed in to **Google Chrome with their Glendowie User Account** and only use Google Chrome for web-based applications whilst at school. If the device is a laptop, please create a **separate user account** for school purposes only.
- Devices brought to school are for the use of my child only. My child will share his/her screen with others during collaborative group work, however my child is in charge of his/her device.
- Children will use cloud based applications such as Google Drive for file management and, with parent permission, are allowed to access this at home. (*We recommend that students only access their device in a communal area and not in their bedrooms*).
- My child will still use traditional means as part of their learning in addition to the purposeful use of their device.
- Rules governing the use of any school-owned digital device will apply to student-owned devices while they are at school. This includes adherence to the Copyright Act and the Glendowie Cybersafety 'Responsible Use' Agreement.
- I understand the device will be subject to internet filtering while connected to the school wireless network. This includes the installation of a security certificate to allow filtering of secure sites.
- I am aware that devices move around the school with the student, and may be used in different areas of the school eg outside, other rooms and in the hall.
