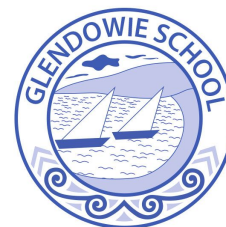


# Glendowie School POLICY

## REPORTING TO PARENTS



### **RATIONALE**

Glendowie School will report to students and their parents on the progress and achievement of individual students, and to the school's community on the achievement of students as a whole and of groups (identified through NAG 1 (c) including the progress and achievement of Maori students against the plans and targets referred to in 1(e) of the national Administration Guidelines

### **GUIDELINES**

- Glendowie School will report on progress and achievement of students across the National Curriculum and in accordance with NAG 2. There will be reporting to students and their parents on the student's progress and achievement in relation to the National Curriculum. Reporting to parents will be in writing, in plain language and will be at least twice a year.
- Other ways of reporting to parents on students progress and achievement include parent teacher interviews and student led conferences
- The school will report school-level data in the board's annual report of student's achievement against the National Curriculum in reading, writing and maths. This will include data of Maori, Pasifika and by gender (where this does not breach an individual's privacy)
