SMOKE FREE ENVIRONMENT PROCEDURE



RATIONALE

Smoking is a health risk and contrary to the healthy role models we promote at our school.

The Smoke-free Environments Act 1990 (and its amendment in 2003) directs that all buildings and grounds are smokefree, 24 hours a day, seven days a week

PURPOSES

- To provide a smoke free environment.
- To display a healthy role model.
- To comply with legislation regarding smoking in public places.

GUIDELINES

- Smoking is not permitted at or on the grounds of Glendowie Primary School.
- Signs are erected in the school and at school entrances
- Contractors and other people working at school are advised of our smoke free policy
- We educate students through the curriculum about the harmful effects of smoking and exposure to secondhand smoke.
- We communicate our policy to new parents through our enrolment packs and our school website
